# ENROLLMENT STEPS - #2 TSI

The Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Assessment tests college readiness.

Students may be exempt from the TSI based on the following scores:

**ACT: Composite 23 with a 19 in both English and Math**

**SAT: Evidence-based Reading & Writing 480 and Math 530**

**STAAR: English 2 EOC score 4000, Algebra 1 EOC score 4000, & Algebra 2 grade 70**

- ✓ **Complete the TSI Pre-Assessment Activity online.**
- ✓ **Pay the \$29 testing fee (online or cashier at any campus).**
- ✓ **Schedule your 3-hour computer-based test at any campus.**
- ✓ **Bring photo ID, receipt for testing fee, and TSI Pre-Assessment Activity certificate with you on testing day.**

## ENROLLMENT STEPS - #3A

**Meet with your WHS counselor to get a  
DUAL CREDIT CO-ENROLLMENT FORM.**

**What course(s) do you plan to take?**

**The DUAL CREDIT CO-ENROLLMENT FORM  
requires signatures from the counselor,  
student, and the student's parent.**



## ENROLLMENT STEPS - #3B      ADVISING

**Meet with an ACC Academic Advisor** on any campus (walk in basis, no appointment) to verify TSI testing and course eligibility.

**Submit the application paperwork**, including the DUAL CREDIT CO-ENROLLMENT FORM, **to the campus Admissions Office.**

Students are able to register for classes 24 hours after submission of all required admission documents.

**Advising is NOT registration.**

For a complete list of courses, please refer to the information at the counseling website. Only courses listed will receive high school credit and be listed on your Westlake transcript.

Frequent courses that WHS students take include:

HIST 1302 – U.S. History 2 =	1.0 credit U.S. History *
	(* CHANGE!!!)
GOVT 2305 – U.S. Government =	0.5 credit Government
ECON 2301 – Principles of Macroeconomics =	0.5 credit Economics
KINE 1304 – Health =	0.5 credit Health
ARTS 1316 – Drawing 1 =	1.0 credit Art 1

# IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- You are starting your college transcript with the grades you make at ACC, so plan to make A's and B's or don't take the class.
- **We DO NOT recommend taking online courses at ACC.** These are college level courses that are taught at the level of AP classes instead of correspondence. Many students do not understand the level of homework required and online classes do not provide the necessary teacher support to understand before the student's grade is low.
- These are college level classes that will give you college credit (as well as high school credit if the class is on Westlake's approved list); hence, the name dual credit.
- **For every hour in class at ACC, it is recommended you spend 2 hours outside of class studying.**
- If you are planning to transfer your ACC credits to another university, it is suggested that you only take courses within ACC's **Core Curriculum**.
